Camp sessions are a fun way for kids 6-12 years old to get an intro to dance and theatre, while our Teen Intensives are for those 12 and older who are looking for a challenge. You'll enjoy a variety of classes every day – acting, singing, hip hop, ballet, jazz, lyrical, tap, stretch...plus performance classes, too! Camps run **Monday to Friday, 9am–3pm**, with a performance showcase at the end of each week. Busy parents will love our Extended Care hours from 8am–6pm, and best of all? There's still room for YOU!

Too young for Summer Camp? The week of August 8-11 we've got classes just for our little ones! Try a **Parents+Baby** drop in class at 9am or our **Parents+Tots** class at 9:30am for just \$5. Big enough for a class without Mom or Dad? Come for **Kids Drop In** classes from 10-11am to get a taste of Creative Movement classes plus crafts and a snack – also just \$5!

Thanks again to all of our students and parents for a fantastic year and a great show. I'm so glad you were all a part of The SPACE this year, and I look forward to having you back in classes next year, too. Here's to a wonderful summer, and I hope to see you all soon!
